15-Sep-20	12:39 PM	from Mahsa Maleki:	Deatlis of the changes: 1) Los Angeles Immigraiton Courts are reopening on September 21, 2020 & USCIS not going on furlough; 2) There were three decisions from Ninth Circuit in favor of DV asylum seekers; 3) There were changes to EAD qualifications for asylees that limits thier ability to get employment card.; 4) Fee waiver qualification has changed, and the change is effective on 10/02/2020; 6) There are immigraiton application fee increases effective 10/2/2020; and 7) there are proposed rule changes for obtaining applications biometrics that proposes to obtain iris image, palm print, or accept DNA test results, which include a partian DNA profile. Children would also need to submit these changes. Comments are due on 10/13/2020.
