DEFINITION: The rate of hospitalizations due to assaultive injuries by spouse or partner (E967.3) per 100,000 females (13 and older)

NUMERATOR: Total number of women (13 and over) hospitalized due to assaultive injuries by spouse or partner (E967.3) by place of residence, in a calendar year

DENOMINATOR: Total female population (13 and older), by place of residence, in a calendar year
