Do you manage a business in the food industry? Need assistance managing surplus food? **We can help!** 

The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health's Nutrition and Physical Activity Program (Public Health) has launched a pilot project to partner with Copia<sup>™</sup> to redistribute surplus food to community-based organizations. The goal of the project is to work with businesses to redistribute surplus food to communities in need, especially during the COVID-19 pandemic.

#### **Donation pickups**



**Eight monthly (twice weekly)** donation pickups and delivery of surplus edible food to nonprofit organizations\*

## **Tracking Tools**



You'll receive access to Copia's donation and food waste **tracking** tools.

### **Support**



Participants get access to Copia's live operations team for **real-time support and management**.

\*One pickup includes one driver with a maximum load of 250 pounds. Pickups can be scheduled "on demand" any day between 9 AM and 5 PM.
