

Housing Navigation Services

Housing Navigation Services



- Housing Navigation (HN) services for Recovery Bridge Housing (RBH) and Recovery Housing (RH)
 clients launched in April 2025
- Housing Navigation assist in identifying permanent housing options and resources
- Clients enrolled in RBH or RH are expected to enroll in Housing Navigation services, unless they meet opt-out criteria:
 - > Have already established a housing plan
 - > Are currently engaged in HN services
- Client referrals must be submitted by RBH and RH providers to <u>designated</u> Housing Navigator within (7) days
- HN providers must review and respond to referrals within five (5) business days
- As funds are available, Housing Navigation provides Participant Assistance Funds (PAF) up to \$1,500 to eligible clients

Field-Based Service Enhanced Benefit FY 25-26

- Benefit: 10% additional payment for FBS on Approved services
- Requirements:
 - Approval to provide FBS
 - Proper documentation of progress notes and claims

Payment Procedures:

- SAPC will review claims, and progress notes every four months to determine the eligible payment amount.
 - Secondary Sage Users must submit a progress note report as outlined in SAPC IN 25-09
- Providers must submit an invoice based on the eligible amount
