

Treatment/Recovery Programs -- Participant Demographics

Chapter 2 describes the population of 2003-04 Fiscal Year program participants by race/ethnicity, gender, and special target groups, such as homeless individuals, pregnant women, youth under 21 years of age, and needle users.

Several salient points in this chapter are:

Treatment/Recovery Program Participants

- The overall Los Angeles County Alcohol and Drug Treatment/Recovery Program served a total of 53,892 participants who accounted for 67,811 admissions. [Table 2.1]
- Three racial/ethnic groups represented 94% of the total participant population (Latino, 40.2%; White, 28.9%; and Black/African American, 24.8%). [Table 2.1]
- Half (50.5%) of the participants were between 25 and 44 years of age. Most (78.8%) of the participants reported completing 9 to 12 years of education. [Table 2.1]
- At admission, 82.1% of participants reported they were unemployed. Unemployment was high for both males (78.7%) and females (89.0%). [Table 2.1]
- Approximately, 1 out of every 5 (18.8%) participants reported being homeless. The percentage of homeless participants was similar for both male (18.3%) and female (19.9%) participants. [Table 2.1]
- The majority (95.4%) of the participants reported their primary drug problem as methamphetamine (21.2%), alcohol (21.1%), cocaine/crack (19.5%), heroin (17.0%), or marijuana/hashish (16.6%). [Table 2.1]
- As shown in Table 2.2, the following characteristics were similar for all racial/ethnic groups:
 - \succ the majority were male;
 - the majority had completed 9 to 12 years of education;
 - the majority were unemployed; and
 - most were between 25 to 44 years of age.

Among Asian/Pacific Islanders and Whites, methamphetamine ranked as the most frequently reported primary drug problem, 33.3% and 30.7%, respectively. The largest percent of Black/African Americans reported cocaine/crack (42.7%) as their primary drug problem. The most frequently reported primary drug problems reported by Latinos were methamphetamine (24.5%), marijuana/hashish (20.3%), and alcohol (20.0%). Native Americans were most likely to report alcohol (29.6%) or methamphetamine (26.8%) as their primary drug problem. [Table 2.2]

Homeless Participants (Table 2.5)

- During the 2003-04 Fiscal Year, a total of 10,154 homeless persons participated in alcohol and drug treatment/recovery programs.
- The majority (64.5%) of homeless participants were male. Most (61.9%) were between 25 and 44 years of age. Over three-fourths (79.0%) reported completing 9 to 12 years of education.
- Cocaine/crack (28.2%), alcohol (23.8%), methamphetamine (22.5%) or heroin (17.1%) was the most likely primary drug problem reported by homeless participants.
- Over three-fourths (76.3%) of the admissions for homeless participants were to residential service programs.
- About one-fourth (23.6%) of the homeless admissions were to nonresidential service programs who then referred these participants for such ancillary services as housing, medical, and vocational rehabilitation.

Pregnant Women (Table 2.6)

- A total of 930 pregnant women participated in alcohol and drug treatment/recovery programs during the 2003-04 Fiscal Year.
- Most of the women were Latino (39.0%), Black/African American (31.0%), or White (26.2%).
- The majority (62.7%) were between 25 and 44 years of age and most (81.9%) reported completing between 9 and 12 years of education.
- One-fourth (26.0%) of pregnant participants reported being homeless at the time of admission.
- Among pregnant participants, methamphetamine (36.5%) was the most frequently reported primary drug problem, followed by cocaine/crack (23.0%).
- The majority (68.1%) of the admissions for pregnant participants were to non-residential service programs.

Youth Under 21 Years of Age (Table 2.7)

- During the 2003-04 Fiscal Year, a total of 10,204 participants under 21 years of age were admitted to alcohol and drug treatment/recovery programs. There were 6,736 under 18 years of age (younger youth) and 3,468 were between 18 and 20 years of age (older youth).
- Youth participants were more likely to be male (66.9%), Latino (61.3%), and completed between 9 to 12 years of education (80.5%).
- Three out of 100 (3.1%) reported they were homeless.
- The majority (52.5%) of youth reported marijuana/hashish as their primary drug problem.
- Older youth (26.5%) were more likely than younger youth (11.2%) to report methamphetamine as their primary drug problem.
- The majority (85.7%) of the admissions for youth participants were to programs that provided non-residential services.
- Older youth (21.6%) were twice as likely to be admitted to a residential program than younger youth (10.4%).

Participants Reporting Needle Use (Table 2.8)

- During the 2003-04 Fiscal Year, a total of 10,936 (20.3%) participants admitted to alcohol and drug treatment/recovery programs reported using needles to administer drugs.
- Seven out of 10 (68.5%) needle using participants were male. Most were either Latino (41.1%) or White (40.8%).
- The majority (54.4%) of participants were between 25 and 44 years of age. Most (80.0%) reported completing between 9 and 12 years of education.
- Among needle users, unemployment was high (83.4%).
- One out of 5 (21.3%) needle using participants reported being homeless.
- Three-fourths (75.2%) reported heroin as their primary drug problem.
- Most (65.4%) of the participants who reported needle usage were admitted to non-residential services.

- During the 2003-04 Fiscal Year, 40,055 participants accounted for 47,444 admissions to non-residential service programs.
- The majority (66.6%) of participants in non-residential programs were male. Most (79.4%) reported completing 9 to 12 years of education.
- Latinos (43.6%) comprised the largest percentage of participants. There were about equal percentages of White (26.1%) and Black/African-American (24.3%) participants.
- Most (47.5%) participants in non-residential programs were between 25 and 44 years of age. It should be noted that 15.5% of participants in non-residential programs were less than 18 years of age.
- Almost one-fourth (22.9%) of the participants in non-residential programs were employed.
- Less than 10% (8.7%) reported being homeless.
- For primary drug problem, there were equal percentages for methamphetamine (20.4%), alcohol (20.3%), and marijuana/hashish (20.2%).

Residential Participants (Table 2.10)

- There were 16,841 participants admitted to residential service programs.
- Most participants in residential programs were White (36.8%), Latino (32.0%), or Black/African-American (25.8%).
- The majority (59.3%) of the participants were between 25 and 44 years of age. Most (77.9%) reported completing 9 to 12 years of education.
- Almost half (46.9%) of the participants in residential programs reported being homeless at time of admission.
- The majority (65.8%) of the admissions were to long-term (> 30 days) residential treatment/recovery services.
- About one-fourth (27.2%) of the admissions were to residential detoxification services.
