<u>Donut Shop</u> :	Shop that primarily sells donuts	
Dairy Shop:	Shop specializing in dairy products (e.g. Altadena Dairy)	
<u>Kiosk:</u>	Small, permanent stand that sells a limited selection of items	
Pharmacy/Drug Store:	Store with pharmacy services (e.g. Rite Aid and Walgreens)	
Liquor Store:	Independent store that specializes in liquor products	
Discount Store:	Store that primarily sells items at discounted rates (e.g. 99 Cent Stores)	
Grocery Store:	Small to medium-sized independent store that sells food items - includes mini- markets, delis, meat markets and produce stores	
<u>Supermarket:</u>	Large-sized chain store that sells primarily food items (e.g. Albertsons, Ralph's, and Vons)	
<u>Tobacco Store</u> :	Store devoted to the exclusive or predominant sale of tobacco, tobacco products, and tobacco paraphernalia.
